Dear Margaret,

I refer to your letter of the 18th February 1988, and apologise for not having replied earlier.

I acknowledge that an amount has now been recovered from Damien Codognotto. I further note that you have now forwarded a further sum of \$750.00.

Quite simply, the current position in relation to the monies is that all outstanding Barristers fees have been paid.

Although there have been a number of statements provided to the Association, it appears that most of these are never sighted by the Committee.

The actual disbursements, noting that no charge was made by myself for the time spent, was as follows -

All these disbursements have now been paid, either from the monies received from the Association or out of the writer's pocket. The writer currently has paid out in excess of \$7,000.00 to cover these sums.
