

We have viewed the criticisms which have been levelled at other MRA's and AMC lobby groups by MRAA (Damien Codognotto), particularly through the MRAA's journal *The Deciding Factor*, with growing disquiet, and we have observed that the comments are becoming increasingly destructive with little emphasis on the truth.
