RE: Future dealings with the MRAA

I must say that after reviewing your email regarding the MRAA web site revamp I was extremely disappointed with your reactions. Your comments were very hurtful personally to Lolla, and as a result, I think we will be looking for a new Secretary and web developer.

Lolla has put in hundreds of hours work in creating the design, gathering information and researching into all of the additional functionality that's present in the web site. All of this has been approved by the board and to ensure that the bigger picture of keeping the site user friendly and easy to navigate was kept in mind. I think she has achieved this well. The board is more than happy with the web site.

While there are some minor changes required for spelling and grammatical errors the sites content will be reviewed by the board and as required changes made. There are varying commercial rates that companies would charge and it would not be uncommon that if Lolla were to charge for her work or we outsourced the work to a company that fees would be in the range of \$80 to \$150 per hour.
