I am writing to you in reference to legal costs imposed on the MRA following the Supreme Court action against the Road Traffic Authority.


As you are aware a joint action was undertaken between the Association and yourself and liability for costs are on a 50/50 basis. On several occasions you made it clear publicly that such costs would be met by yourself. However correspondence received from you has indicated that you see yourself no longer responsible for any such costs. If this is the case then the Association will be deemed to be liable for the total costs.

As Treasurer of the Association, I have a responsibility to the members to clarify this matter formally. I therefore seek, in writing, notification as to your position with regards to your liability towards costs imposed.

Furthermore the 'Yellow Brick Road' fund set up by yourself needs some explaining. Do you intend to pass any funds collected onto the MRA in order to maintain regular payments to Bryan Gurry & Co, and if so would you please inform this Committee accordingly.

This matter will be brought before the AGM in order to inform the members of the status of the legal costs payments.
