Mr. Codognotto,

On August 1st, at the Annual General Meeting of the Motorcycle Riders Association, you failed in your job as President to ensure that a full and detailed financial report was presented to the membership. This is both unconstitutional and illegal. — NOT TRUE

On August 2nd, your own Vice President requested a copy of the Associations financial report, and under the Constitution, you had 30 days to comply with that request, and you failed to do so. That is both unconstitutional and illegal. — A CHEQUE BOOK HAS BEEN STOLEN.

On August 10, I requested copies of the Associations financial report and a financial report for the 1991 and 1992 Toy-Runs plus a complete set of tapes of the AGM. I am still waiting for you to comply, with and send me, what was requested. Again you have failed, again it is unconstitutional and illegal. — TAPES SUPPLIED TO SERRY HALL — AS ABOVE.

On August 19, you were sent a letter requesting a Special Meeting of the members of the Association. You questioned that letter and refused to act on it's request until your Board out-voted you and suggested that you set a date. You yourself said that it would be advertised in The Age, in the motorcycle section, the saturday after that board meeting, September 11. Again you have failed to ensure the job was done. — NOT TRUE — ONLY 16 5 MEMBERS CALLED THE S.M. — WE CAN'T USE THE AGE BECAUSE DETLEF ACTED AGAINST INSTRUCTIONS

Mr. Codognotto, I'm sure that by now you must have had your fun with your little delaying tactics. If an advertisement does not appear in the motorcycle section of The Age this coming saturday, September 18, announcing the time, place and reason for the special meeting, I shall take legal action.

You should do yourself and the Association a big favour and resign, but I fear that would be expecting too much.
