## Notice for the Return of Group Stationery

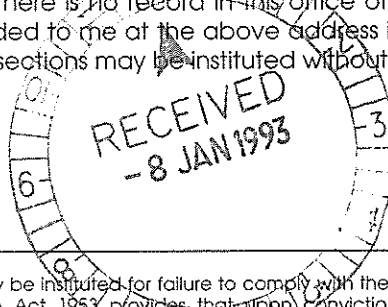
Year Ended 30 June 1992

The documents should be provided to me at the above address immediately as prosecution action for breaches of the above sub-sections may be instituted without further notice.

**NOTE:** Legal proceedings may be instituted for failure to comply with the requirements of the legislation. Section 8E of the Taxation Administration Act 1953 provides that upon conviction for a first offence of this nature, a fine not exceeding \$2000 may be imposed. For a second offence, a fine not exceeding \$4000 may be imposed. For a third and subsequent offence, a fine not exceeding \$5000 or imprisonment for a period not exceeding 12 months, or both, may be imposed and in respect of a company, a fine not exceeding \$25 000.

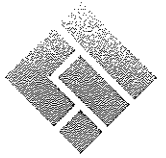

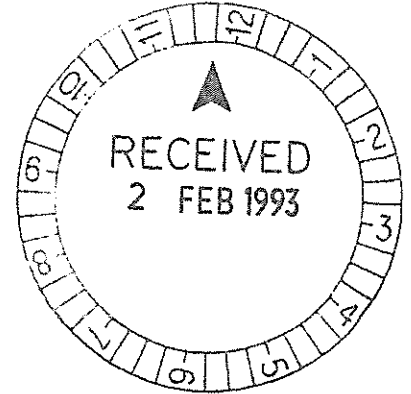

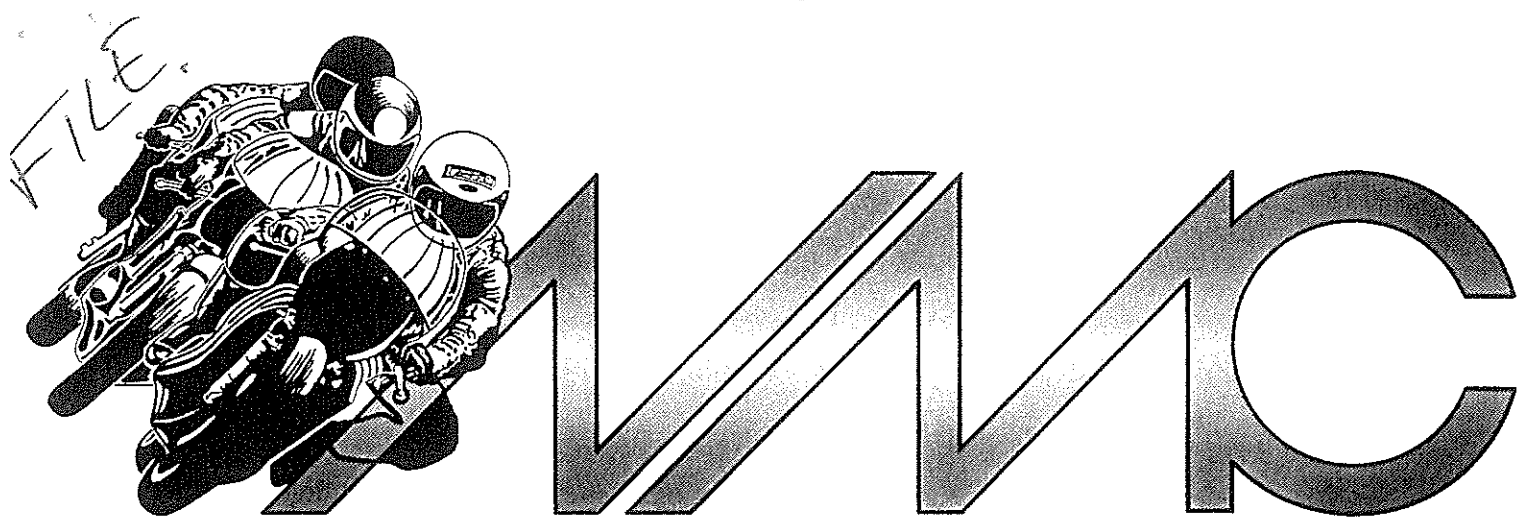

Dear Mark,

firstly, my apologies for not having been in touch for so long. It has been a very difficult two years. The recession has made it virtually impossible to earn a living from insurance while increasing the number of people in the community who need help.

As you would have guessed my paperwork is way behind but I just have not been able to afford either the time or the cash to get them up to date. As you see from the attached paperwork I can no longer hide from the backlog.

It took days to get through to the ASC in Morwell. But I finally got onto a Peter Steinkellner (051 20 3931) who is in the ASC Compliance Department. Fortunately he is a motorcyclist and appreciates what I do so it seems I have a few weeks, four or five, to start getting paperwork to him.

A friend of mine, Jo Nelson, knows my office (mess) and is prepared to do the book keeping for me. This would suit me as I can give her a key to this office and she can do the books here at times which suit both of us. 568 6374.

But I am assuming too much. I hope you will still be prepared to do The National Motorcycle Consultants accounts. I am beginning to have enough income to get things up to date again and I attach a cheque for \$500 as a deposit if you are able to help me.

What I would like to do with NMC is get the books up to date by the end of this financial year then put it to sleep. By that I mean I would like to suspend its operation for a year or two while I work NMC Motorcycle Insurance as a business name and derive my income from commissions and work the MRAA should be able to give me in future. I do not want to lose the various things NMC P/L has built up but I have to get ahead so I have to simplify things.

The MRAA is going ahead and that must help me earn a living and pay off some of the bills outstanding as far back as the 1990 Grand Prix. We have just achieved a major legislative change regarding motorcycles as commercial passenger vehicles and this opens the way for us to get back into tourism. Also, Julian Butler now works for Tourism Tasmania and we have a couple of ideas for the future.

I will be most grateful if you can help me again.
