

A brief history of the Victoria

The grand lady was built by a lady. Back in the 1880's the Beaconsfield Parade Beach front was becoming a popular health and pleasure resort. In 1887 construction began on the Kerferd Road Pier. The scope for a large hotel was abundant and a Mrs McGregor filled it with the "Victoria" sited strategically opposite the pier. She built a monument to the booming confidence and wealth of a colonial era. From the early 1950's till the beginning of the 1980's the hotel went into a period of decline. The Schütz family purchased the hotel in 1983 with the intention of transforming the building back to its original glory. After seven years of hard work, uncompromisingly thorough restorations and several million dollars, the Victoria is now the hotel it was many years ago, and it is thought of by many to be the number one of Melbourne's small hotels. The hotel is a significant South Melbourne landmark. It is one of the most intact nineteenth century hotels in the area and has been classified by Australia's National Trust.




